Health, Education and Welfare called to order by Chairman Seaboyer at 9:10 p.m.

Chairman Seaboyer says the auditor has certified that the funds are available for
transfer.

Mr. Hughes says that \$8200 is for part-time salaries for two college graduates that were
retained through the fall which enabled the department to get a jump start on the
springtime work. One of them returned to work in January. He says there was an
emergency in February that cost \$3000. An underground cable that was not clearly
marked was cut near a grave.

Alderman Conn asks if there is a shortfall in any of these accounts. Mr. Hughes says
no, that he and John Scenna reviewed all of them. Alderman Conn asks if the City owes
money to the two part-time students; Mr. Hughes says no, that the transfer will balance
the books.

Alderman Boisselle asks if there is more underground cable running through the
cemetery. Mr. Hughes says there is only one, but that it was not clearly defined. The
repair will be addressed next fiscal year. Alderman Boisselle asks if it was a power
cable. Mr. Hughes says it was a 9000 volt National Grid cable and that thankfully no one
was hurt.

Alderman Conn moves to recommend, 2nd by Alderman Forbes. All in favor.

Alderman Tramontozzi motions to adjourn, 2nd by Alderman Conn. All in favor.

says when the committee last met on this there was a question about why this is necessary.

Alderman Tramontozzi motions to suspend the rules so that Mr. Beshara may address the Board, 2nd by Alderman Seaboyer. All in favor.

Mr. Beshara says that \$1060.00 is for software needed due to the change in Daylight Savings Time. It is used to time stamp receipts at the train stations. Alderman Tramontozzi says the order should be amended to include \$438.00 for rolls of tickets. Mr. Beshara says yes.

Alderman Seaboyer says there are three train station parking lots and asks if this software is for all three machines. Mr. Beshara says yes.

Alderman Tramontozzi motions to amend the appropriation to \$1,498.00, 2nd by Alderman Conn. All in favor.

Alderman Conn moves to recommend as amended, 2nd by Alderman Seaboyer. All in favor.

Order 07-176, Be it ordered that the Building Inspector investigate whether the storage of construction equipment on a vacant lot on 160 Green Street constitutes a violation of the Zoning Ordinances of the City of Melrose. Said storage is prohibited in all zoning districts other than I and BB, BB1, see attached table of uses. In the event that the Building Inspector agrees that there is a violation, he should initiate an enforcement action forthwith. (AL-2, AL-1)
