Dear Chairman MacMaster,

Pursuant to the above referenced City Council order, the status of the final restoration on Green and Howard Streets is as follows

- 85 Green Street sidewalk repair was completed in the fall of 2021
- Per the city's specifications, final restoration on Howard Street is anticipated to begin the week of April 18, 2022, weather dependent, in the vicinity of between 72 Howard Street and 179 Howard Street.

Restoration work along Howard Street is expected to take 7 days, and traffic management will be coordinated with the city's police department.

This restoration work will complete Eversource's Mystic to Golden Hills Reliability Project in the city of Melrose.

On behalf of the entire Eversource team, thank you and your residents for the patience, cooperation, and understanding that you've extended to us throughout the duration of this Project. This Project improves the reliability of greater Boston's electric grid, and we are grateful for your partnership in working to accomplish this goal.
