- 02-223 Regular meeting of the Board of Aldermen to be held in the Aldermanic Chamber, City Hall, Melrose, MA on Monday, March 4, 2002 commencing at 7:45 P.M.

HIGHWAYS

- 02-228** Requesting that a representative of Verizon appear before the Board of Aldermen to discuss Verizon policies and procedures for removing duplicate telephone poles in the City of Melrose. (AL-1 & AL-3)
- 02-230** Requesting the Melrose Traffic Commission review a proposal pursuant to Melrose City Ordinances, Chapter 220, Schedule I, Isolated Stop Signs, by adding; >Hawley Road>east and west>Hayes Avenue and report the Commissions findings to the Board of Aldermen. This review is necessary due to a four-way intersection that has no signage determining who has the right of way. (A-2, AL-2)
- 02-231** Requesting that the Melrose Traffic Commission review a proposal for street signage on Linden Road between Green Street and Main Street pursuant to Melrose City Ordinances, Chapter 220, Article IV, Section 220-54A, and report the Commissions findings to the Board of Aldermen. This review is necessary due to the concerns of the residents of Linden Road. They have expressed concerns of abnormally high volume of vehicles parking in front of their homes and blocking their driveways. (A-2, AL-2)
- 02-235 Requesting that the Melrose Traffic Commission review a proposal pursuant to Melrose City Ordinances, Chapter 220, Schedule I, Isolated Stop Signs, by adding; >Bay State Road>east and west> Hayes Avenue and report the Commission's findings to the Board of Aldermen. This review is necessary due to an extremely high volume of traffic in the neighborhood. (A-2, AL-2)

LEAVE TO WITHDRAW

- 01-191 Requesting the Mayor to consider providing Melrose Public Works with \$60,000 of additional funds in this years city budget for the purpose of a new "Pothole Program". These funds would be used to properly fix the many potholes throughout the city. The "Pothole Program" will target those potholes that were temporarily fixed over the winter, with a more permanent method of fixing over the spring and summer seasons. (A-2)
- 01-297 Establish a working group that will be charged with creating and maintaining a five-year roadway improvement/maintenance plan regarding the upkeep of city roads. Group to report back to the Board of Aldermen by October 1, 2001. Composition of committee set forth herein.
