02-238 Regular meeting of the Board of Aldermen to be held on Monday, March 18, 2002 in the Aldermanic Chamber, City Hall, Melrose, MA commencing at 7:45 p.m.

TABLED:

02-230 Requesting the Melrose Traffic Commission review a proposal pursuant to Melrose City Ordinances, Chapter 220, Schedule I, Isolated Stop Signs, by adding; >Hawley Road>east and west>Hayes Avenue and report the Commissions findings to the Board of Aldermen. This review is necessary due to a four-way intersection that has no signage determining who has the right of way. (A-2, AL-2)

RECOMMEND AS AMENDED as amended, by deleting "Hayes Avenue" and inserting in place thereof "Hawes Avenue."

02-231 Requesting that the Melrose Traffic Commission review a proposal for street signage on Linden Road between Green Street and Main Street pursuant to Melrose City Ordinances, Chapter 220, Article IV, Section 220-54A, and report the Commissions findings to the Board of Aldermen. This review is necessary due to the concerns of the residents of Linden Road. They have expressed concerns of abnormally high volume of vehicles parking in front of their homes and blocking their driveways. (A-2, AL-2)

02-235 Requesting that the Melrose Traffic Commission review a proposal pursuant to Melrose City Ordinances, Chapter 220, Schedule I, Isolated Stop Signs, by adding; >Bay State Road>east and west> Hayes Avenue and report the Commission's findings to the Board of Aldermen. This review is necessary due to an extremely high volume of traffic in the neighborhood. (A-2, AL-2)
