- 01-127 Regular Meeting of the Board of Aldermen, Tuesday, January 16, 2001 commencing at 7:45 P.M.

- 01-128 Appropriation of \$22,281.25 from A/C #21102-590000, Mount Hood Greens Fees, to A/C #016532-565100, Mount Hood Debt Interest. The appropriation is necessary for Treasurer to make interest payments on Mount Hood grant.
- 01-129 Appropriation of \$3,420.00 to A/C #015112-529000, Health Department Professional Services to be taken from Available Free Cash. The appropriation is necessary for a substitute nurse for three months at the Winthrop School, as the current nurse is on family medical leave.
- 01-130 Appropriation of \$156,387.00 to A/C #614512-529200, Water Division, MWRA to be taken from Water Enterprise Available Free Cash. These funds are necessary to cover the budget for the MWRA water assessment for the current fiscal year, which is finalized each year after our budget is developed, based on estimates received by the MWRA.
