02-071 Regular Meeting of the Board of Aldermen, Monday, October 1, 2001, commencing at 7:45 P.M.

Appropriations

02-075 Transfer in the amount of \$8,000.00 to account # 011551-511000, Salary and Wages from account # 011552-522000, Telephones. This transfer is necessary to fund Information Technology support specialist/senior clerk position through December 31, 2001.

02-078 Requesting the approval by the Board of Aldermen to provide authorization for the City of Melrose Treasurer to issue bonds and/or borrow funds in the amount of \$1.5 million dollars, for the purpose of construction, stabilization and environmental remediation at Mount Hood Memorial Park and Golf Course.

02-068 Requesting that the Honorable Board of Aldermen hold an Election for a Ward six (6) Alderman to fill the vacancy created by the Resignation of Anthony P. Salamanca.

Leave to Withdraw

- 01-349 Be it ordered by the Melrose Board of Aldermen that the following Question be placed upon the Ballot at the City Election to be held November 6, 2001: "Shall the Melrose School Committee be changed from a nine member committee with all members elected to serve two year terms to a nine member committee elected to serve four year staggered terms: four members elected for four years and five members elected to serve two years following adoption of this question at the next municipal election, and all subsequent members to be elected for four year terms?" - 02-024 Requesting that the President of the Board of Aldermen be authorized to seek and retain counsel for the Board of Aldermen to represent the Board in connection with the Mount Hood Memorial Park & Golf Course and Big Dig Fill Project. (AL4)
- 02-045 Requesting that the Board of Aldermen order that any governmental body, committee, or advisory group established by the city, the Mayor, the Board of Aldermen, or any city officer or department other than the School Committee or School Department, shall be subject to the provisions of Massachusetts Open Meeting Law, MGL CH. 39, Sec. 23B and shall only hold meetings after 4:00 P.M. or on weekends or holidays in order to ensure public access and participation. Upon written notice to the Mayor, the City Clerk, and the President of the Board of Aldermen that an emergency requiring immediate attention exists, meetings before 4:00 P.M. may be held provided notice is received at least 2 hours prior to the meeting and posted in City Hall, or if City Hall is closed, in a public area at the Police Station.
