Melrose Conservation Commission Minutes for February 26, 2015

Ms. Murphy called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM.

Discussion Item:

Max Kasper, the contractor doing the work at 21 Lake Ave., which is located on the bank of Ell Pond. Mr. Kasper explained the work now required for an additional footing. Originally, Mr. Kasper had notified the Conservation office of constructing a new deck on the footings of where an old deck had been. Because there was no earthwork being done, he was advised that he didn't need to file. Now that the architect drawings are done, the architect feels another footing is necessary. The work is 60' from the pond edge and will be hand dug. The footing will be 10"x10" and any excess soils will be disposed of. It was felt that silt fence was not necessary.

Invoice:

An invoice was received from Valleycrest Tree Care Services for the arborist to go out to 22 Leonard Rd. The bill was for \$350.

Ms. Hickey moved to approve the invoice from Valleycrest Tree Care Services in the amount of \$350. Mr. Weieneth seconded the motion, and it was voted unanimously in favor.

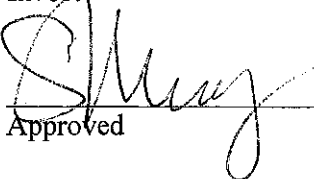
Minutes:
