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Melrose Conservation Commission Minutes for June 20, 2013

Ms. Murphy, Chair, called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM.

Minutes

Ms. Hickey moved to approve the minutes of May 23, 2013. Ms. Heacock seconded the motion, and it was voted unanimously in favor.

77 & 79 Messenger Ct. (217-0187) – Continued Public Hearing

71 Cranmore a/k/a Off Cranmore (217-0166) – Certificate of Compliance
