Alderman Seaboyer motions to take Order No. 09-238 from Committee, 2nd by Alderman Forbes. All in favor. Order No. 09-238, Class II Motor Vehicle License – Application for a Class II Motor Vehicle License to Martial Simonis d/b/a Lebanon St. Auto Sales at 303 Lebanon Street, Melrose, MA

Alderman Forbes moves to suspend the rules to hear from Mr. Simonis, 2nd by Alderman Medeiros. All in favor.

Mr. Simonis says he lives in Everett and worked at Gillette Company in South Boston for 20 years before retiring 3½ years ago. He's bored staying at home and was looking for something to do. He bought this business on Lebanon Street.
