Order No. 07-107C, Proposed Ordinance amendment to Melrose Revised Ordinances Chapter 198, §198-5 through §198-10 – Solid Waste as submitted by the Solid Waste Committee as set forth herein. (AL-4)

Alderman Infurna moves to recommend for discussion purposes, 2nd by Alderman Boisselle.

As the maker of the order, Alderman Seaboyer says there is a bit of history to this order. The Solid Waste Committee was charged with rewriting the order which was broken up. This is the last phase of updating the Solid Waste code. It has been approved by the DPW and the Board of Health and was sent to the City Solicitor who defined the fines.
